### **Department**

To assist in the brewery pilot plant with the various projects. The prime focus is within the pilot plant, but may also be asked to perform other work within the Brewing Services department.

- Taking measurements of samples and recording data
- Moving kegs, malt sacks and various ingredients. Must be physically fit
- Performing CIP duties on brew days
- Learning the brewing process with the opportunity to perform brewing tasks
- Other duties within Brewing Services
