Department

The role will involve a range of analyses on wine and spirits plus working with the LIMS system. This is a busy laboratory and requires rapid turnaround times for results. There is an opportunity to learn about wine (an interest in this topic will be an advantage). The role will suit someone with good analytical skills, who can work in a busy environment and is well organised.

The Role

To provide technical support and assistance to the Wine and Spirits team. To deliver analytical results using existing methods and work with the LIMS system.

Duties and responsibilities:

- Carry out analysis of wines and spirits according to instructions, within agreed timescales and work with the LIMS system
- Maintain full and up to date records of all work performed manually and automated, and all aspects of quality control
- Calibration, maintenance and daily monitoring of laboratory equipment, e.g. balances, pipettes
- General housekeeping
- Learning new analytical techniques as required

Qualifications and competencies

- A degree in a science subject and/or relevant experience
- Work accurately within specified time frames
- Computer literate – proficient use of Word, Excel & Power Point
- Good written and verbal communication skills
- Practically minded and able to work in a team
